



CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT MARCUS D. WASHINGTON

Chief Master Sergeant Marcus D. Washington is the Command Chief Master Sergeant, 59th Medical Wing, Joint Base San Antonio-Lackland, Texas. he serves as the 59th Medical Wing Commander's Senior Enlisted Leader, overseeing the Air Force's only medical wing consisting of 5,600 personnel manning six groups across four installation and two geographically separated locations. he is responsible for the health, welfare, morale, and professional development of the wing's 3,500 enlisted members.

In addition, Chief Washington champions the wing's multipronged mission of providing worldwide contingency medical support, home station comprehensive healthcare services, clinical research, graduate medical education, and medical force technical training for 16 Air Force enlisted medical career fields – more than 15,000 trainees per year – to enhance worldwide mission readiness.

Furthermore, he serves on the Medical Education and Training Campus Board of Directors, overseeing 48 training programs and 18,500 graduates annually. Chief Washington also serves as the San Antonio Military Health System Senior Enlisted Leader, advising the Market Director on healthcare delivery and support to 255,000 beneficiaries and 35,000 basic military



trainees in 11 Army, Navy, and Air Force integrated medical treatment facilities, with a \$1.1 billion budget, in the San Antonio metropolitan area.

Chief Master Sergeant Washington entered the Air Force in October of 1997 as a Diet Therapy Technician and graduated the Diet Therapy Fundamentals course in Feb 1998 at Sheppard Air force Base Texas. He has served in key roles as a Military Training Leader and a First Sergeant, Squadron and Group Senior Enlisted Leader, and MAJCOM Functional Manager.

Before assuming his current position, Chief Washington served as the Air Force Special Operations Command Chief of Medical Enlisted Forces HQ AFSOC, Hurlburt Field, Florida.
